

Format of the written progress reports:

In the second year and again in the third year the student delivers a report of maximum 3.000 words which describes:

- Background
- Progress made
- Problems encountered with discussion of the reasons
- Future goals
- Experimental plan
- Time plan
- Publication strategy

The format of the report should assume the format of a thesis. However, if enough results have been obtained and on recommendation of the direct supervisor, it can alternatively be written in the form of a publication including an extended discussion and outlook part describing future experimental plans. These reports are read by the TAC members and must therefore be delivered to them two weeks in advance of the TAC meeting.
